DEVELOPING SHOW RABBITS OR REPLACEMENT BREEDERS

Note: We recommend feeding Bluebonnet® Kindle Bits 18 until rabbits reach 4-6 weeks of age to help ensure an optimum start.

After rabbits reach 4-6 weeks of age, feed Rabbit Booster 16 as a premium quality developer or continue using Kindle Bits 18 if you prefer. Use the chart below as a guideline for daily measured feeding levels or offer feed free choice.

DEVELOPING FRYERS

Note: We recommend feeding Bluebonnet® Kindle Bits 18 until rabbits reach 4-6 weeks of age to help ensure an optimum start.

After rabbits reach 4-6 weeks of age, feed Rabbit Booster 16 as a premium quality developer ration, or use Bluebonnet® Rabbit Ration 15 if you prefer. Use the chart below as a guideline for daily measured feeding levels or offer feed free choice.

ADULT MAINTENANCE

Feed Bluebonnet® Rabbit Booster 16 as a premium quality adult maintenance ration. Use the chart below as a guideline for the daily measured feeding levels. Avoid overfeeding mature adult rabbits. If rabbits become overweight, reduce the daily feeding levels.

FEEDING CHART FOR RABBIT BOOSTER 16

Monitor the condition of your rabbits frequently and adjust daily feeding levels to achieve desired results.

Body Weight	Amount to Feed Daily
Adult Small Breeds up to 2.5 lbs.	1.5 to 2 oz.
2.5 to 4.5 lbs.	2 to 2.5 oz.
4.5 to 6 lbs.	3 to 3.5 oz.
6 to 8 lbs.	3 to 4 oz.
8 to 10 lbs.	4 to 6 oz.
10 lbs. and up	6 to 8 oz.

For best results with lactating does and young rabbits under 4 weeks of age, use Bluebonnet® Kindle Bits 18.

IMPORTANT: If other grains or ingredients are mixed with this product, the blend should be reviewed by a nutritionist to be sure the resulting mix is nutritionally balanced. Feel free to call us. Salt spoons may be used, if desired.

WARNING: DO NOT FEED TO SHEEP OR OTHER COPPER SENSITIVE ANIMALS.

NOTE: Provide plenty of fresh, clean water at all times. Keep feed fresh in cool, dry storage. DO NOT use feed that is old, molded or insect contaminated.
