Elevated levels of calcium and phosphorus as well as trace minerals, such as copper and zinc, have been shown to have a positive effect on bone and tissue development in growing horses. The product is designed to supply these necessary nutrients in a dense, easy to feed 3/4" cube that can be eaten off of the ground.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

All Horses: Feed quality hay/pasture at a minimum of 1.5% of horse's body weight.

Breeding/Growing Horses:

- Pregnant Mares: Feed 3 to 5 lb daily.
- Lactating Mares: Feed 5 to 8 lb daily.
- Growing Horses: Feed 5 to 8 lb daily.
- Stallions During Season: Feed 5 to 8 lb daily.

Adult Maintenance Horses: Feed 3 to 5 lb daily.

Performance Horses:

- Light Activity: 3 to 5 lb daily.
- Moderate Activity: Feed 4 to 6 lb daily.
- Intense Activity: Feed 5 to 8 lb daily.

Important Feeding Information:

- Transition horses onto this feed gradually over 14 days.
- Increase or decrease daily feed to obtain the desired growth, weight gain or body condition.
- Offer clean fresh water and plain white salt at all times.
- Weigh feed and divide feed into two or three separate feedings for best results and safety.
- Store in cool dry area away from rodents, insects and moisture.
- Do not use feed that appears old, molded, or has an unusual odor.
